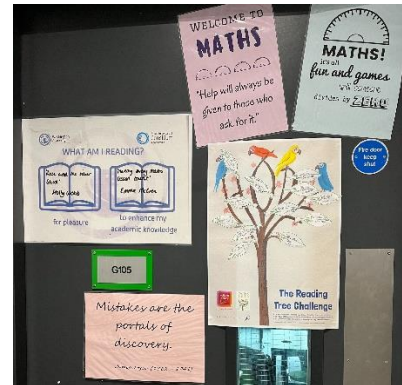
Community Incidents
