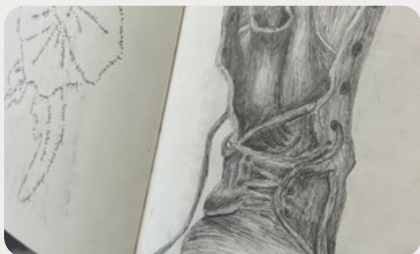

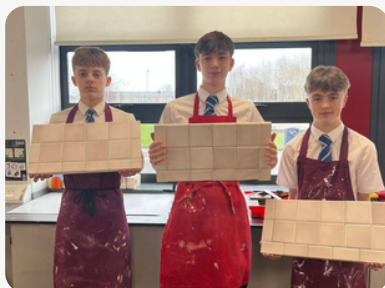

Huge congratulations to House Eagles. First win in over a year and crowned this half-term's house winners!



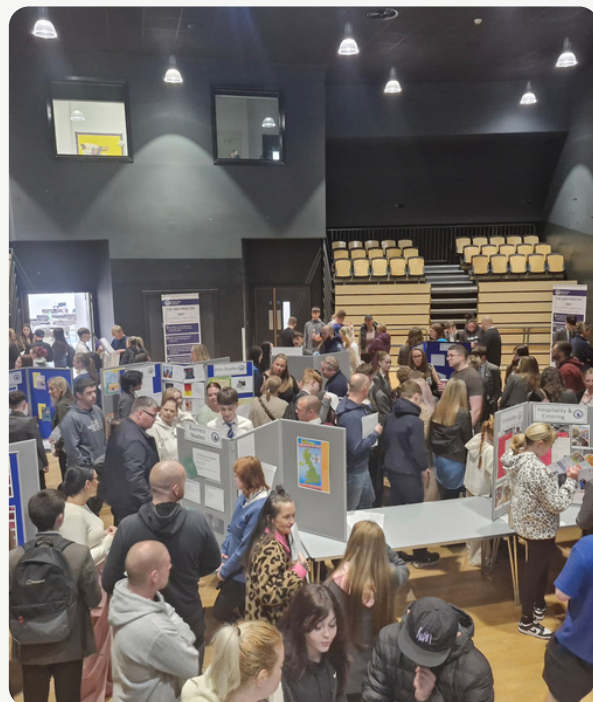
Huge well done to our Year 10 Construction students who finished off their tiling project last week.
